## **CAST COMMITTEE**



The Community Advocates for Safe Teens (CAST) committee is dedicated to preventing youth substance misuse.

- Works to increase awareness of Oklahoma's Social Host law through various advertisements and initiatives.
- Operation Prom and Operation Graduation promote drug-free celebrations for students.
   Through partnerships with local schools, youth organizations, and law enforcement, these initiatives ensure safer proms and graduations.
- Promotes Red Ribbon Week and other campaigns that empower youth to make informed decisions and resist peer pressure.
- There has been more than 5.5% decline in underage drinking among 8th and 10th graders from 2016 to 2020 in Comanche county.
- There has been a increase in the perception of self-harm associated with underage drinking, with a 3.9% rise among 12th graders in Comanche county from 2016 to 2020.
